I would like to offer this letter of commendation on behalf of the A.L. Huber General Contracting Company as a nominee for the AGC Building Excellence Award.

The A.L. Huber Company was the general contractor for the renovation of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City, MO. This was a major renovation project of a building over 120 years of age. In such a project considerable complexity was present, demanding solutions to often unexpected problems. Their use of manpower was outstanding, managing not only to achieve maximum results but with an extremely personable relationship with both foreman and workers. They were always pleasant and promptly and willingly answered questions that arose. They gave the impression that this job was the most important thing before them. This was true even in the rigorous enforcement of job site safety. Even I, as rector and pastor was not permitted to wander around the premises without my hard hat! They had an effective policy for procedures to promote cooperation and communication between me, the architects, the "steering committee" and the larger diocese. This was, I consider, a major achievement in itself!
